ISU HORSE SHOW RULES

GENERAL RULES

All horses will be under the care and supervision of their owners. Show management will not be responsible for injury to horses or attendants.

Horse show office will open at 7:30 am.

Entries must be paid at the time of entry.

Classes will be evaluated using the rules from the AQHA Judges Handbook.

Classes are open to any breed, registered or non-registered horses

Jackpot classes are not covered in all day fees. Jackpots will pay class entry plus \$7 at the gate for the jackpot. Jackpots will be paid back 40%, 30%, 20%, 10%. Jackpot classes do not count toward high point awards.

When an exhibitor, owner and/or representative displays unsportsmanlike conduct and/or inhumane treatment of a horse while on the show grounds, the show management may suspend such individual(s) from competition. No refund of entry will be made.

Classes may be added or scratched up to the class immediately preceding the class in which the exhibitor wishes to add or scratch.

Dogs must be kept at your trailer.

Age will be calculated as of January 1st.

Stallions must be shown by an adult.

AWARDS

High point awards will be given for High point and reserve in 12 and under, 13-18, and 19 and over age divisions.

Placings will be awarded 1st-5th. In classes of 5 entries or more, points will be tabulated based on the number of entries in the class if a class has 10 entries points would be distributed as 1st-10 pts, 2nd-9 pts, 3rd-8pts, 4th-7pts, 5th-6pt. If there are only 3 entries in a class, 1st-3pts, 2nd-2pts, 3rd-1 point.

Winners will be determined by adding the points earned by each contestant and each horse in which s/he has placed in the top six. Points are compiled on a one-horse, one rider basis. In the event of a tie, tie breakers will be 1) who earned points in the greatest number of events, 2) who earned the most points in the riding classes and 3) greatest # of first places.

ISU, the horse judging team and its members will be in no way responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and each exhibitor shall hold the horse show management blameless for any loss or accident to his/her horse or equipment which may occur from accident, sickness, fire or otherwise. All owners and exhibitors will be responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to the barns or properties on the show grounds. Each exhibitor must sign a waiver, exhibitors 18 years or under must have a parent/guardian sign.

All classes except jackpot and grand/reserve halter will count toward high point.

Knocking over a barrel or pole will result in a 5 second penalty in the speed event classes.
